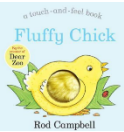
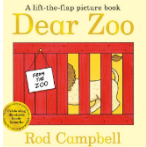
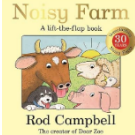




Nursery – Autumn Two

PRIME AREAS OF THE CURRICULUM: These are the prime areas of learning which must be developed first to ensure that children are ready to learn: - To learn to wait their turn whilst talking with an adult or friend. - To know how to be a kind friend. - To tidy up my resources when I have finished with them - To understand how their actions make others feel	HELPING AT HOME: Please support your child by practicing the following at home: Learning our names – Miss Nalson, Mrs Foster and Miss Hill. Using their manners. Waiting their turn. Listening carefully to instructions. E.g. tidying toys. Toileting – pulling their trousers up and down by themselves. Washing their hands. Taking their coats on / off. Putting shoes and socks on. Joining in with Nursery rhymes. Listening to a story.	NURSERY RHYMES: Head, shoulder, knees and toes. I like to eat ... I can sing a rainbow. Autumn Leaves. Twinkle, Twinkle, Little Star.	USEFUL PHRASES: Please Thank you Can I have a turn please? I need the toilet.
