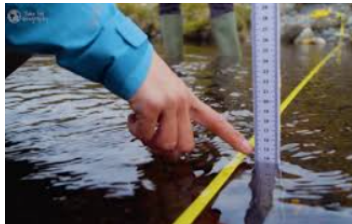




YEAR 1- Autumn 2

Our Topic this half term: In Geography, we will complete fieldwork to help us find out more about our local area. In PE, we will be learning a dance routine. We are getting crafty and creative in Design and Technology with a sliders and levers project to make our Christmas card. In Music, we will be learning the songs for our Nativity 'It's a Baby!		Writing: In English we will be continuing our Autumn senses poem - asking the children what they can hear, see, feel and smell on their Autumn walk! We will then move on to our winter themed writing where we will further explore adjectives to describe and create a Christmas poem. We will finish the term by reading the 'Jolly Christmas Postman' and writing our own simple letter to Santa focussing on the Magic 5.	Maths: In Maths we will be further exploring addition and subtraction including fact families. We will also be learning about different shapes and their properties. We will be consolidating counting 2's, 10's and 5's and applying this knowledge to our addition and subtraction problems.
