#### **KEY LEARNING IN MATHS:**

In Maths, Nursery will be learning to subitise up to 5 - we will be learning to know the quantity up to five, just by looking!

We will also be focussing on learning the principles of counting. These include: The one - one principle (to count each object just once), The stable - order principle (to count numbers in a certain order) and The cardinal principle (to know that the final number said is the total).

- To understand how their actions make others feel
