Year I - Spring I

None core Topic work:

In History, we are going to be starting a new unit on Victorians. We will be learning who Queen Victoria is, comparing rich and poor Victorian households, how Victorian toys differ from ours and what schools were like in Victorian times.

In Geography, we are learning about Cities. We are going to learn the 4 cities in the UK, what the capital city of the UK is and what landmarks we may find in cities.

In Science, we will be learning about the human body. We will be learning about the 5 senses and how to look after ourselves.

Writing:

In English we will be continuing to practise applying our phonic knowledge to our independent sentence writing.

We will be writing sentences based on the following books:

The Little Red Hen Man on the Moon The day the crayons quit

Maths:

In Maths we will be exploring place value up to 20. We will be ordering and comparing numbers to 20, finding out I more and I less and representing numbers to 20 in different ways. We will be continuing to consolidate our number bonds to 10 and will continue practising our 2, 5 and 10 times tables.
