OUR TOPIC FOR THIS HALF TERM:

In RE, we will be looking in depth at Judaism, discussing things that are important to this faith, sacred items, places and beliefs. In our Science lessons, we will be learning about animals including humans, looking at offspring and how they change and the effects of healthy eating and exercise on the human body. We are getting creative in Art by making sculptures. In Computing, we will be looking at the different tools we can use to create a digital painting.

KEY LEARNING IN MATHS:

In Maths we will be exploring money. In this topic we will be consolidating our recognition of coins, adding and subtracting money to find change.



We will then be moving on to multiplication and division where we will look in depth at the 5, 10 and 2 times tables, followed by more formal methods of calculating multiplication and division problems.
