

# Year 1 - Spring 2

## None core Topic work:

PE days are now Monday and Thursday.

In History, we will be continuing our learning around Victorians. We will be learning about what it was like to attend a Victorian school and how Victorian toys differ from ours.

In Geography, we are learning about Cities. We are going to learn the 4 cities in the UK, what the capital city of the UK is and what landmarks we may find in cities.

In Science, we will be learning about the human body. We will be learning about the 5 senses and how to look after ourselves.

## Writing:

In English we will be continuing to practise applying our phonic knowledge to our independent sentence writing.

## Maths:

In Maths we will be exploring place value up to 50. We will be ordering and comparing numbers to 50, finding out 1 more and 1 less and representing numbers to 50 in different ways. We will begin practising one more and one less to 20 as a key instant recall fact and should be able to answer these questions in a couple of seconds. We will also continue practising our 2, 5 and 10 times tables.
